  - PPP Payroll protection plan Applications are currently been accepted for the second round of funds available, however it is expected that funds will again run out quickly. It is imperative that applications be submitted ASAP. Tips for successful submission and use:
    - i. Apply with a small community bank (not BOA, Chase, Wells Fargo, etc.)
    - ii. Create a separate bank account to track how funds are spent
    - iii. Clarification that the determination of the loan is based on the first \$100K of salary per employee, not including benefits.
  - HHS Funding

A careful review of the terms and conditions is needed, especially around the specifics for balanced billing. Several organizations have had to return the money. It was noted that returning the funds may be difficult so do not wait until the last minute. Once of the issues is also the wording change of "possible to presumptive" cases of Covid19

- IRDL Emergency Funds
   This fund is offered by the SBA during times of emergency. It is felt that at this
   time the funds have been spoken for and may not become available. Updates
   will be provided as details become known.
